Please note the following information to help you all settle in.

Staff.

All our staff are carefully selected and undergo Police vetting and barring checks. All staff are committed to the highest outstanding standards of the Montessori Philosophy and childcare.

Notice Boards.

Please check the door notices regularly. The notices along with the regular news letters e-mailed will keep you updated with all the Special events at the Nursery. Information is also available on our website www.ladybirdbosham.co.uk

Uniform. Please label all uniform.

The children wear Navy Blue Sweatshirts or cardigans and White Polo shirts all of which can be purchased at the Nursery. Blue check summer dresses for summer and up to mid October can be purchased from Marks, Sainsburys, Tescos etc. Your child will need a school bag with a spare set of clothes and LABELLED Wellington boots to put in our boot bucketsand kept at nursery. Sunhats for the summer. Children must wear sensible safe shoes, preferably with Velcro. No crocs or flipflops please. Your child will need slippers or indoor shoes to be kept at nursery and a named waterproof apron for painting.

Parent meetings

Parent meetings or stay and play parent events are held twice a year. We realize that the relationship between the Child's parents and the school is crucial to your Childs well being, development and progress. Each child has a key teacher who will keep you updated with your Childs individual progress during their time at Ladybird.

Sickness and Medicine.

We cannot accept a sick child into the Nursery. If your child becomes unwell at nursery we will contact you. Please see the infection and illness policy on our website. Due to Ofsted regulations we are unable to give children medication unless we have your written permission and instructions before hand.

Snack and lunches

Part of our Early years and OFSTED requirements are to encourage healthy, balanced and nutritious meals and promote oral health.

The first steps nutrition trust http:www.firststepsnutrition.org/ provides information to support eating well from pre-conception to 5 years from experienced nutritionists. They have an amazing web site with many packed lunch ideas and portion sizes all at a low cost!

Please could you provide your child with a bottle of water(no juice please) and a piece of fruit a banana or satsuma or chopped up fruit in a container in the lunch box. Milk or water and a breadstick is offered to the children at snack time Children will need a packed lunch if staying for a morning session. No peanut butter, nuts,frube squeezy yoghurts,crisps or chocolate or sweets please. Packed lunches are stored in the classroom and should contain a healthy sandwich or pasta with perhaps some chopped up cheese or vegetables,carrots/cucumber etc or fruit and a small treat.Small containers are also much easier for the children to open. Please could small cheddar biscuits etc be put in a small pot. No packets please.Children may have yoghurts in a pot with a spoon

Toys

We would ask that children keep their toys at home as we have lots of lovely toys to play with at Ladybird. New children needing a teddy or comforter is of course perfectly acceptable.
