Early years funding can be used during all the morning and afternoon periods but children will be expected to attend for a full morning session to complete the full Montessori work cycle and therefore will be paying for the additional hours .All pre-school school children are encouraged to attend a minimum of 3 mornings.

Our priority is to provide full day sessions where possible E.G 8.30 -3.30 and therefore parents choosing to access these sessions will have first priority.

We have some places available using the Early Years Funding for 15 hours per week afternoons only for 2 and 3 year old's without any additional fees.
