Please can the children dress up in something festive for this event. Some suggestions would be snowmen, reindeer, elves, angels, anything to do with Christmas. There will be lots of lovely Christmas outfits in the big supermarkets/charity shops/Vinted. We do have a few outfits at nursery if you would like some help with this.

If this is your child's normal Monday session, please bring them to school in uniform with their outfit in a bag clearly marked with their name. If your child does not normally attend this Monday session, please can they be brought to nursery at **11.15 am in their Christmas costume.**

We have always allowed parents to take photos and videos at this very special event and would like to continue to do so. If any parent has any concerns with this matter, please speak to Beckie before the end of November. Please do not post any photos, other than of your own child, on social media.

Please note that the Christmas concert is always very busy. For safety reasons, children will be released to their parents from the stage door immediately after the concert, for parents to look after them. Please bring some pennies for our local charity pot.

Christmas party

Friday 12th December

Children to come dressed in their party/Christmas outfit. No uniform.

Children who do not normally attend this Friday session are invited to be dropped off at the party at **11.00 and collected at 12.30**. We will be playing games and having a party lunch provided by Ladybird, so no packed lunch is needed. Nursery will close for the Christmas holidays at 12.30.

Please can the presents be secretly handed to a member of staff during the week of the party.

Online applications are open. Closing date for school applications is 15th January 2026.

Snack and lunches

Part of our Early Years and OFSTED requirements is to encourage healthy, balanced, and nutritious meals and promote oral health. Please could you provide your child with a named water bottle (**no juice please**) and a piece of fruit which will be shared at snack time. Milk or water and a breadstick/cracker are also offered to the children at snack time. Children will need a packed lunch if staying for a morning session.

No peanut butter, nuts, frube squeezey yoghurts, crisps, chocolate or sweets please. Packed lunches are stored in the classroom and should contain a healthy sandwich or pasta with perhaps some chopped up cheese or vegetables, carrots/cucumber, etc, or fruit and a small treat. Small containers are also much easier for the children to open. Please could small cheddar biscuits, etc, be put in a small pot. No packets please, this encourages the child's independent skills and helps them with their school readiness. Children may have yoghurts in a pot with their own spoon.
