PARENT'S KEYPERSON MEETINGS. 6th-11th June

This is an opportunity for parents to come and have an informal chat at drop off or pick up with your child's keyperson and see your child's early learning journal. (Appointment times will be arranged nearer the time.)
We will be able to give you information on your child's progress and development, tips on being ready for school and what we have been working on this term. For instance, rhyming words, extending vocabulary, pencil control, phonics, numeracy and what the children could practice at home to be school ready.

Our annual Sports Day is held on the recreation ground behind the school. All the children are involved in the events. This is always such a fun occasion and we hope as many Parents, siblings and Grandparents will be able to attend. The event will finish at mid-day. Parents are welcome to bring a picnic to enjoy on the field after the event. **Nursery will be closed for the afternoon.**

even more time outside this term and we take the water bottles outside. The no nut and peanut butter policy remains due to some children being allergic to nuts.
